Specified Procedures in Private practice

Note 1, ISP Level 1 : this category includes any or all of the following procedures:

- Fixed or removable orthodontics , in the absence of any specialist training or higher registerable qualifications in orthodontics
- Placing of implants in the mandible or maxilla, including the use of bone grafts but excluding sinus lifts or bone augmentation which involves the floor of the sinus, or extra oral bone harvesting- which are classified as level 2 (2SP) or level 3 (3SP) procedures

Note 2 2SP level 2

Placing implants in the mandible or maxilla, including sinus lifts or bone augmentation which involves the floor of the sinus , but excludes extra oral bone harvesting- which is classified as a Level 3 (3SP) procedure

Note 3 : The 'facial aesthetic procedures' category **includes** full general dental practice, including (where the member has been specifically authorized in writing by the Singapore Dental Council), Botulinum Toxin, Dermal Fillers, and/or wrinkle reduction treatments in the lip, the immediate peri-oral area including the naso-labial folds, glabella, forehead, around the eyes but excluding the neck.

Note 4 : 'Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons' means someone who is trained and registered by the Singapore Dental Council in the specialty of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery.

DIRECT MEMBERS: The Direct members' rates apply to members who join Dental Protection/MPS directly, as opposed to membership through the Singapore Dental Association.

Specified Procedures in Private practice

Note 1, S1D Level 1 this category includes any or all of the following procedures;

- c) Fixed or removable orthodontics , in the absence of any specialist training or registerable qualifications in orthodontics
- d) Placing of implants in the mandible or maxilla, including the use of bone grafts but excluding sinus lifts or bone augmentation which involves the floor of the sinus, or extra oral bone harvesting- which is classified as level 2 or level 4 procedures

Note 2 S2D level 2

- a)placing implants in the mandible or maxilla, including sinus lifts or bone augmentation which involves the floor of the sinus , but excludes extra oral bone harvesting- which is classified as a Level 4 procedure
- b) bone harvesting from anywhere other than the mandible or maxilla

Note 3 : The 'facial aesthetic procedures' category **includes** full general dental practice, including (where the member has been specifically authorized in writing by the Singapore Dental Council), Botulinum Toxin, Dermal Fillers, and/or wrinkle reduction treatments in the lip, the immediate peri-oral area including the naso-labial folds, glabella, forehead, around the eyes but excluding the neck.
