Saving teeth one pulp at a time!

SYNOPSIS

The advent of new biocompatible pulp-capping materials has led to a renewed appreciation of the role of vital pulp therapy as a treatment approach in restorative dentistry, particularly in carious mature permanent teeth. Taking reference from latest literature, this talk aims to provide vital updates regarding the case selection of teeth likely to benefit from these treatment modalities, as well as a discussion of techniques and materials used. Riding the wave of the “minimally invasive” movement, the speakers hope to generate heightened awareness of the importance of saving teeth, one pulp at a time!

Dr. Lim Wen Yi is currently a registrar in the Endodontic Unit of the Restorative Department in National Dental Centre Singapore (NDCS). She received her Bachelor of Dental Surgery from the National University of Singapore (NUS) Faculty of Dentistry in 2011 and was a Dean’s List awardee. Following which, she pursued her specialty training in Endodontics and obtained her Master of Dental Surgery (MDS) from NUS in 2016. She was a recipient of the Society of Endodontists Singapore Medal for achieving a distinction at the Final NUS MDS Conjoint Exams with Royal College of Surgeons Edinburgh.

Dr. Lim maintains a special interest in pulp biology, particularly in the management of vital inflamed pulps. She had previously researched on the histology of dental pulps with pulpitis indicated for partial pulpotomy during her endodontic training. She is currently supported under the Budding Clinician Researcher Scheme offered by NDCS to study the pathophysiology and wound healing of inflamed dental pulps as a part-time doctoral candidate in Lee Kong Chian School of Medicine, Nanyang Technological University.

Dr. Tan Shao Yong graduated with the Bachelor of Dental Surgery from the National University of Singapore in 2010. Between 2010 to 2012, Dr. Tan served as a dental officer with Ministry of Health in Singapore, where he worked at the School Dental Services and Khoo Teck Puat Hospital. He subsequently obtained the Master of Dental Surgery (Endodontics) from the National University of Singapore in 2015 and was awarded Society of Endodontist Singapore Prize for the best student in Endodontics in the Final Master of Dental Surgery examination. He has previously presented at regional conferences such as the Society of Endodontists Singapore-Malaysian Endodontic Society 10th Joint Scientific Meeting in 2016, and the 19th Scientific Congress of Asian Pacific Endodontic Confederation in 2017. Dr. Tan currently practices at the Khoo Teck Puat Hospital in Singapore.
