## **SES Scientific Meeting 2018 - The 10 Steps for Predictable Apical Microsurgery**

***\*Early bird registration closing in 3 weeks!***

When performed atraumatically, the 10 Steps for Predictable Apical Microsurgery will eliminate stress for the operator, and decrease unfavorable results for the patient. Suture removal in 24-48 hours, with no significant post-operative pain, or swelling, is to be expected.

4. Make a Complete Thickness Incision
5. Atraumatic Flap Elevation

8. Root-end Procedures: REB and REP

10. Sutures, Healing, and Post-op Care
