Once again, a dental team will be going to Qinghai, China. This time, the team will be based in a village at Zhao Xiao Xiang. The dental clinic is part of a mission team comprising a Women and Children Clinic, Eye Clinic, and TCM Clinic.

We are currently looking for both old and new volunteer dentists to form a team of 12.

Volunteers need to be able rough it out on long 12 hour road journeys, high altitude of 4000m, no baths for 6 days, cope with freezing night temperatures. Our non-clinical logistics will be handled by a support team of volunteers; food, transport and accommodations.

Much time will be spent travelling 3 days in, 2 days out and 4 clinic days in between.

Dental work will be mainly restorative work and extractions.

Expected personal cost is about \$2100.

We would appreciate any connections to anybody who can help with the purchase of medicines and dental equipment in China. Donations towards this mission will also be greatly appreciated.
