His recent books include *Health as Liberation* (1996), *Medical Ethics* (with D.G. Jones and G. Gillet, 3rd Edition 2005), *The Body in Bioethics* (2009) and *Bioethics: the Basics* (May, 2013). He was formerly chair of the Ethics and Governance Council of UK Biobank and is currently a member of

the Bioethics Advisory Committee to the Singapore Government.
