## **Stiffer Enforcement Penalties and Enhanced Support Programmes to Address Workplace Accidents**

MOM has issued a Media Release with regards to harsher penalties on WSH infringements with immediate effect. This is in response to the 28 fatalities since the start of this year, which represents a 30% increase compared to the same period last year. The stepped up enforcement by MOM has also seen

more than 40 SWOs being issued since April. These indicate that the WSH conditions on the ground has not improved.
