Professional Conversion Programme for Dental Surgery Assistants 2018 Intake

Dear SDA Member

Workforce Singapore (WSG) is inviting employers to be sponsoring employers for the next Professional Conversion Programme (PCP) for Dental Surgery Assistants (DSA) intake in March 2018.

About the PCP

The PCP for DSA aims to equip locals (Singapore Citizen (SC)/Permanent Residents (PR)) with relevant skill-sets to remain career resilient and match them into good jobs in dental services. The Programme is a sponsorship programme where shortlisted locals with no prior experience in dental assisting

will be employed and sponsored for the NITEC in Dental Assisting course. The course is a 12-month part-time programme that is held at either Singapore Dental Association (SDA) or National Dental Centre Singapore (NDCS), ITE's 2 approved training centres. Trainees will work full-time with sponsoring employers and be provided On-The-Job training during the course duration. Employers may impose a bond on candidates upon completion of the programme. Funding

WSG will provide grant support to employers at the following rates:

Component	WSG Grant Amount
Course Fee (Per Trainee)	SC/PR: 70% of course fees capped at \$3,925.24 (before GST) <i>(additional 20% of course fees claimable via SCN for eligible trainees/SMEs of approx. \$1,121.50)</i>
Salary Support (Per Trainee)	SC/PR: 70% capped at \$1,750 per month for 12 months = \$21,000
	Mature/LTU* SCs only: 90% capped at \$2,250 per month for 12 months = \$27,000
Maximum Grant Per Sponsored Trainee	SC/PR: Up to \$24,925.24
	Mature/LTU SCs only: Up to \$30,925.24 <i>(additional \$1,121.50 claimable via SCN for eligible trainees/SMEs)</i>

**LTU is defined as unemployed and actively looking for a job for at least 6 months.*
