SES Scientific Meeting 2018 - The 10 Steps for Predictable Apical Microsurgery

When performed atraumatically, the 10 Steps for Predictable Apical Microsurgery will eliminate stress for the operator, and decrease unfavorable results for the patient. Suture removal in 24-48 hours, with no significant post-operative pain, or swelling, is to be expected.

Course Outline:

1. Prepare the Staff, Instruments, Equipment
2. Position the Patient, Doctor, and Assistants
3. Anesthesia and Hemostasis Staging
4. Make a Complete Thickness Incision
5. Atraumatic Flap Elevation
6. Atraumatic Tissue Retraction
7. Access, RER, and Crypt Management
8. Root-end Procedures: REB and REP
9. REF Techniques and Materials
10. Sutures, Healing, and Post-op Care



Dr. Stropko received his DDS from Indiana University in 1964. After serving in the United States Air Force as a captain in the Dental Corps, he practiced general and restorative dentistry until 1987, then decided to further his education and pursue specialty training in endodontics. In 1989, he received a Certificate for Endodontics, from Dr. Herbert Schilder, at Boston University, and returned to private practice, as an endodontist, for the next 23 years.
